Hear about each sectors' current status, their present challenges, maybe their outlooks, and engage in the debate with the speakers.

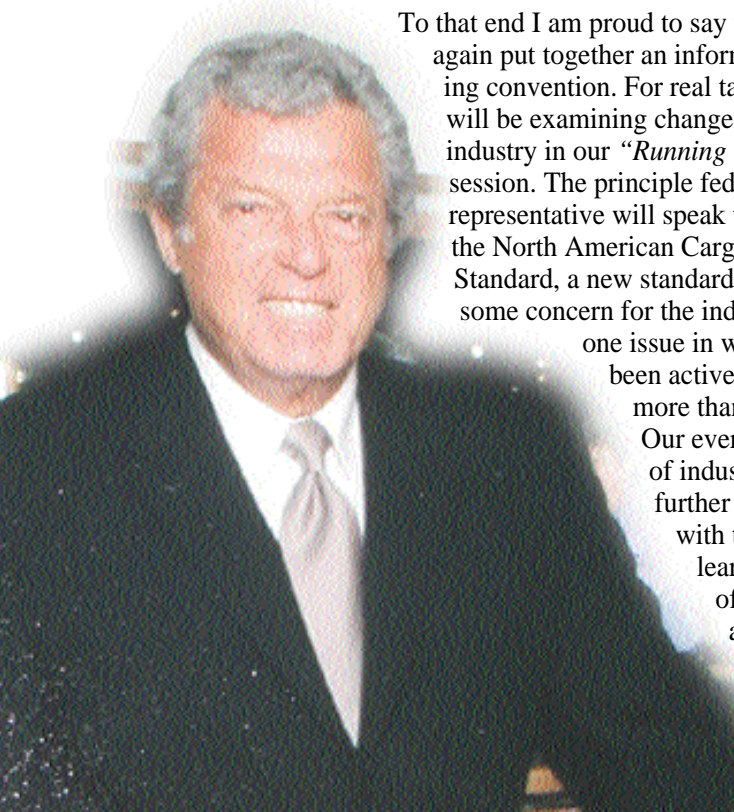
